Today, in our 29th season, over 60 young people ages 7-18 participate in our performing ensembles. SAYChoirs is committed to providing quality music education for youth, with the firm belief that the choral experience instills essential life skills in young people: cooperation, self-confidence, focus, and dedication. The four successive choir levels build on these skills and provide a safe, positive space for growth, expression, and artistry.
