CHOIR OUTLINE

ABC is a beginning vocal music experience for 5 and 6 year-olds. The Kodály method is used to introduce singing concepts and general music.

Piccolini is an entry-level choir. Students study basic choral technique and beginning theory.

Grazioso is an entry-level choir. The choral and theory techniques are slightly more advanced than those of the Piccolini Choir.

Spirare continues to study more advanced literature and participates in community performances.
